UPDATE:

As of March 15 2020 the City of Calgary has declared a state of local emergency to limit the **community** spread of COVID-19. The following measures have been implemented:

- 1) Schools, libraries, recreation centers and classes, daycares are closed
- 2) All public and religious spaces are to limit their capacity to 250 or half their capacity whichever is lower.
- 3) Social distancing
- 4) Limited public access to spaces
- 5) Working from home when possible
- 6) Ghost shifting recommended when at all possible

In light of this news Calgary has a reasonable low risk of transmission at this time.



Calgary Italian Bakery's Strategy:

- Follow all established GMPs.
- Frequent Hand Washing.
- Increased Janitorial Cleaning.
- Limit outside visitors to the facility to only those required for operation.
- No unscheduled pick-ups or deliveries.
- All employee who have travelled will be required to complete a 14 day self-quarantine.
- Suspended travel to all countries deemed a risk by the CDC Website.
- Staff will work from home if at all possible.
- We have closed our Deli Store until further notice.

Conclusion:

Our facility is complying with social distancing by reducing staff and limiting visitors.

This Report will be reviewed as the situation develops and will be resent if any changes are required to our Food Safety Strategy.
